Guidelines to Faculties for setting Question paper:

1. Online MCQ Exam needs to be conducted for 50 questions of 1 marks each (with mixed difficulty level containing 20 Easy , 20 Medium & 10 Difficult questions) (This classification should not be mentioned in the question paper for students .)
2. The marks secured by students out of 50 are required to be scaled up to 60 marks as End Sem Exam is out of 60 marks.
3. Confidentiality needs to be maintained. Score/marks should not be disclosed to the students.
4. Google form /MS form to be used for examination purpose. Quizizz app should not be used.
5. While finalising the internal marks out of 40, please refer to the scale down chart attached and do the needful.(Compare the marks of ESE Exam after scale up to 60 with internal marks out of 40)
6. Ensure Coverage of all CO.
7. The questions should be from entire syllabus
8. Adherence to guidelines of University of Mumbai(UOM) is necessary.
