Dear Sir,

I am writing this with reference to your application (a) No. EC/CO/14336/82-83, dated 25th March, 1983 and (b) No. EB/771/83-84, dated 5th January, 1984, requesting recognition, under Section 46 of the Bombay University Act, 1974, of the Bharati Vidyapeeth's Institute of Management at New Bombay, for teaching the courses of studies mentioned below :-

- (a)
1. Master's degree in Management Studies (M.M.S.)
  2. Master's degree in Financial Management (M.F.M.)
  3. Master's degree in Administrative Management (M.A.M.)
  4. Master's degree in Marketing Management (M.M.M.)
  5. Diploma in Management Studies (D.M.S.)
  6. Diploma in Administrative Management (D.A.M.)
  7. Diploma in Computer Management (D.C.M.)
  8. Diploma in Marketing Management (D.M.M.)
  9. Diploma in Managerial Accounting (D.M.A.)
  10. Diploma in Tax Management (D.T.M.)
  11. Diploma in Operations Management (D.O.M.)

(b) M.L.S. (Caster of Labour Studies).

The committee which visited the Institute on 2nd May, 1984, has submitted its report.

The report of the committee has to be considered, in the ordinary course by the Academic Council and the Executive Council. However, as the meeting of the Academic Council has not yet been fixed and as there is urgency to the authorities of the Institute of knowing the decision of the University in regard to your application, the report was submitted to the Vice-Chancellor. The Vice-Chancellor has approved the report in exercise of his powers under Section 11(4) of the Bombay University Act, 1974 and has asked me to inform you as under.

The Institute of Management at New Bombay to be started by the Bharati Vidyapeeth from the academic year 1984-85, is recognised, under Section 46 of the Bombay University Act, 1974, for preparing students for the M.M.S. degree and the Diploma in Management Studies for a period of one year with effect from 20th June, 1984, subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions.

That the authorities of the Bharati Vidyapeeth give an undertaking

1. that they will immediately set the plans for the Institute Building proposed and approved by the concerned authorities and send copies of the same to the University by the end of September, 1984.

2. that they will ensure that the Institute building is completed in all respects, and is fit for occupation and use with all fixtures, fittings and appliances, as well as suitable and adequate furniture by June 1985;
3. that they will give an assurance in writing that deficit if any, of the Institute will be met by Bharati Vidyapeeth from its own resources;
4. that they will run only one part-time post-graduate management course in addition to M.M.S. programme during 1984-85;
5. that they will spend Rs.50,000/- on books and Rs.10,000/- on periodicals and journals during 1984-85;
6. that they will follow the prescribed procedure for selecting and appointing full-time faculty for M.M.S. programme and make cuts and adequate faculty arrangements including at least one full-time faculty member to be in charge, for D.M.S. programme during 1984-85 and two more full-time faculty members by June 1985;
7. that they will provide adequate signature for students, office, faculty, library etc. during 1984-85;
8. that they will deposit the first instalment of Rs.50,000/- towards the Reserve Fund of M.S. Tekur, by November, 15, 1984;
9. that they will appoint the Librarian and other library staff by selecting persons with the prescribed qualifications during 1984-85;
10. that they will ensure that students coming from long distances are not inconvenienced because of lack of transport facilities;
11. that they will admit only 60 students to M.M.S. I class in 1984-85 from among those M.M.S. applicants of 1984, who have cleared the Common Admission Test organised by Bajaj Institute but have not obtained admission to any other recognized Institute in Bombay;
12. that they will communicate to the University before and of June 1984, whether the name of the Institute will be Bharati Vidyapeeth's Institute of Management, Bombay.

A copy of the report of the committee is enclosed herewith for your information and necessary action.

In regards the teaching of the M.L.S. degree course, the application in that behalf will be considered in due course of time as requested by you vide your letter No.B77B/1194/84-85, dated 11th June, 1984.
