Infrastructure of IMSR

Institute has adequate academic infrastructure and facilities in the Institute premises. These facilities are according to the norms and requirements of AICTE, New Delhi, DTE, Mumbai and University of Mumbai. The management of the institute takes proper steps to maintain this academic infrastructure and facilities.

The Institute has a sprawling campus. Nestled amongst beautiful hills and spread over 0.5 acres, one would not imagine that this serene campus is in such proximity to the industrial belt that employs millions and contributes so much to the state and even the country.

The academic infrastructure facilities includes adequate fully equipped classroom with bench, computer with roof mounted projectors installed in each classroom, internet facility with Wi-Fi connectivity is provided in entire building and Institute premises. It also includes Playground, Gymkhana and Sports Facilities, Canteen and Health Center with first aid room and

common room for boys and girls along with seminar hall.

Library Facilities

BVIMSR Library is at the heart of the Academic Centre, designed to meet the academic and research needs of the business students. BVIMSR Library is an open system. Library is stocked with subject related books, general management books, personality development books, books on competitive examinations, encyclopedias, National and International Journals, Magazines, newspapers both English and local language, CD and research reports. For the smooth running of book distributions KOHA & OPAC Software is used in Library. BVIMSR library has a vast collection of 32519 volumes which includes more than 554 reference books, 6523 titles as well as 12,000 e-books of management disciplines. Library subscribes to 60 national journals and international journals of management. It is also subscribed J-gate& PRO-QUEST, Social Service Sciences, E-books.





IT Infrastructure

Institute is having total 160 desktop computers, 12 processors and 5 laptops. Desktop computers are organized in computer laboratories, language lab, faculty cabins and administrative office. Total 115 desktop computers with Microsoft applications are arranged in two computer laboratories with internet connectivity of 100 Mbps Network on optical fiber. Desktop computers and laptops is also made available to all the students and faculty during the college working hours and also extended hours as per the need.

- ♦ All the faculties are provided with desktop computers in their respective cabins and Laptops are also available for special purposes.
- ♦ All the computers are available with Internet facility of 100 Mbps Network on optical fiber.
- ♦ All computer laboratories are supported with UPS power back up facilities and further supported by Generator.
- ♦ All the classrooms are equipped with processor/ CPU, overhead projector and an audio system.
- ♦ All the computers are protected from virus using Quick Heal antivirus software.
- ♦ Few computers have the special software like SPSS version 22.0 to meet the research related work requirements.
- ♦ BVIMSR campus is Wi-Fi enabled with speed of 1 mbps per person. Students, teaching and nonteaching staff can access internet within 30 meters radius of the campus.
- ♦ The entire IT infrastructure is setup and maintained by two dedicated IT support staff.



Language Laboratory:

The purpose of a language lab is to involve students to actively participate in language learning exercises and get more practice than otherwise possible in a traditional classroom environment.

Institute has procured software from 2016 onwards.

- Institute has I-Tell- Orell Digital Language Lab to equip students to improve the language proficiency.
- Faculty and students wear headsets that block outside sounds and disturbances.
- Students have a media player/recorder for listening to audio and recording speech.
- A server computer or a separate storage device is often used to store lesson materials in a digital format.

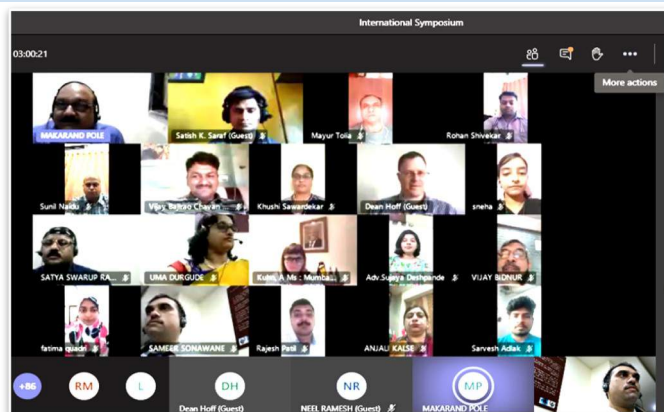

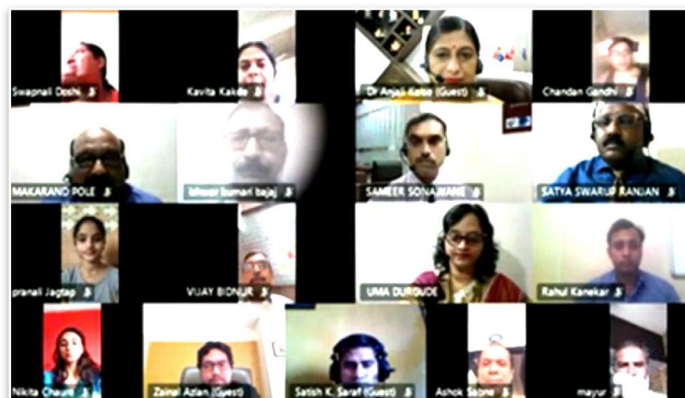
post COVID-19. The symposium had also received wide media coverage

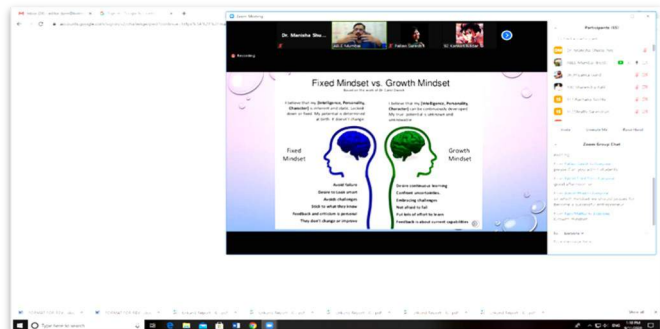

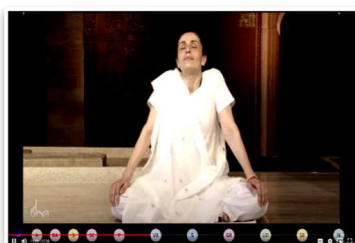
Workshop by Eminent Entrepreneur

Yoga for Immunity and Respiratory Health

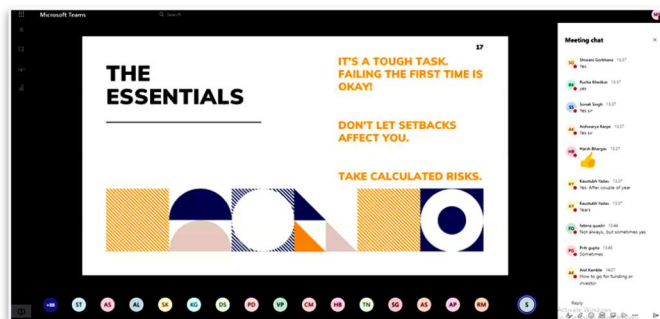


Yoga is an immensely rich and highly complex spiritual tradition and a means to join the individual soul with the universal soul. The basic aim and function of Yoga

Dare to Dream - A Start Up Story

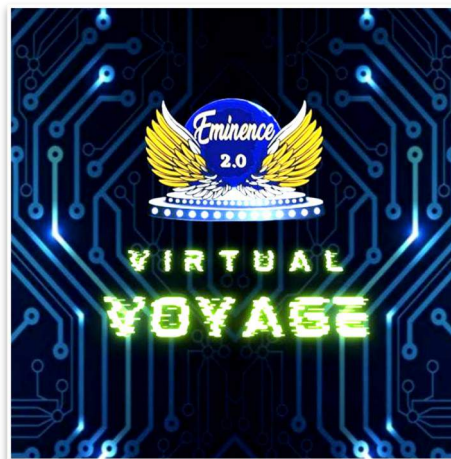

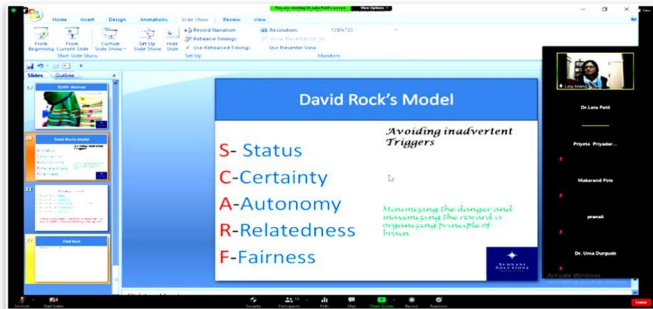
dances from various Indian states. The second day was even more exciting that included tambola, brandwiz, Fitness Freak, Story Telling, Ad Making, & Reel Making.

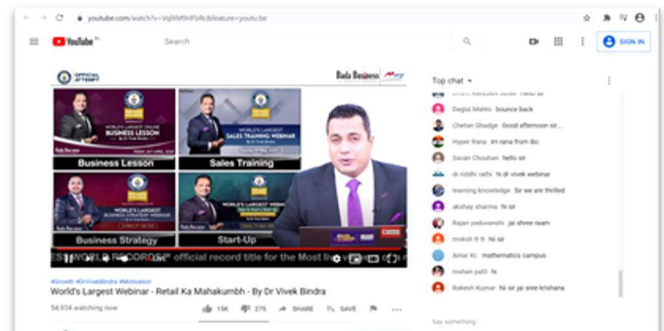
FDP on Research Publication and Analytics

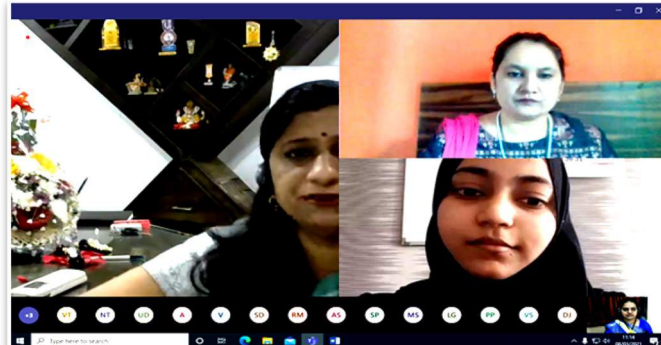

International Women's Day Celebration

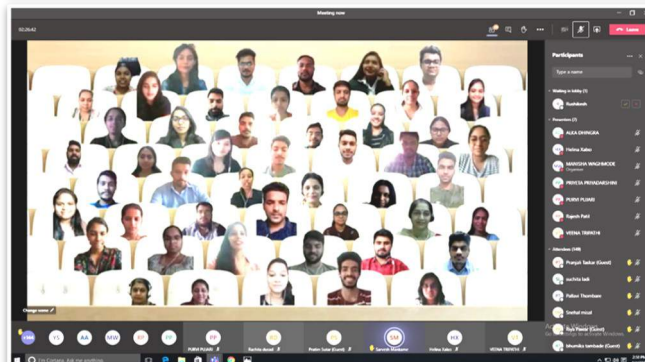

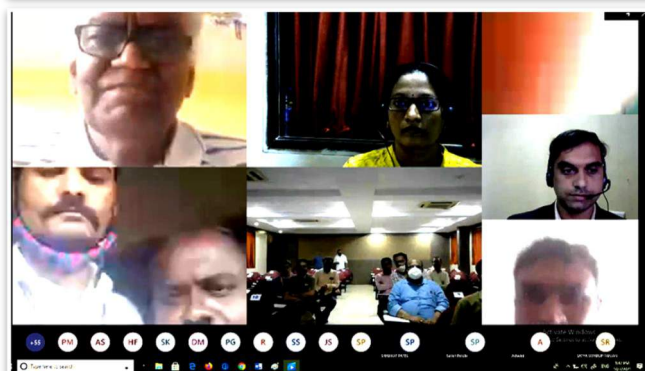
Induction and Orientation Program (Online) for MMS 2020-22

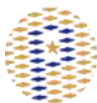
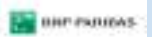
